Identify your facility's needs and determine your objectives, including high-priority vs. low-priority tasks and goals for the coming quarter.



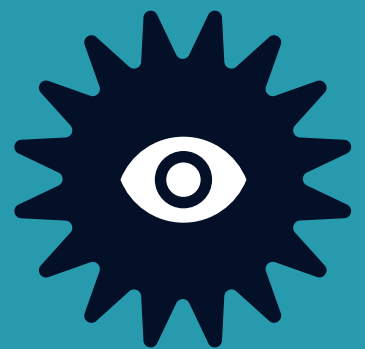
### 02. Define Your Metrics

Avoid data overload by narrowing down and defining the exact metrics you want to use, and how they adhere to your objectives. Find a way to communicate your results to stakeholders.



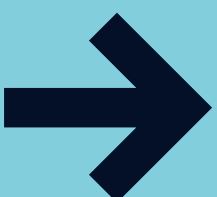
### 03. Use S.M.A.R.T. Goals

Re-evaluate and review your most important goals and organizational objectives, then make sure your goals are **specific, measurable, attainable, relevant and time-based**.



### 04. Leverage FM Software
